2. Be mindful of and respect the property of the facilities we are using and other individuals. Respect the schedule of the convention with promptness. You will be personally involved in the restoring if you are personally involved in the damaging.
3. No guys in girls' rooms and no girls in guys' rooms – FOR ANY REASON – even devotions or group meetings.
4. Possession or use of alcohol, tobacco, drugs, weapons, or fireworks is not permitted.

Now you are a huge key to what can happen this week. Expect the life change that only Jesus can bring to our lives, behave, and ENJOY!
